## POOL FAQs

**Q. How big is your pool?**

A. The big pool is 25 yards x 16 yards with a depth from three feet to six feet. The small pool is 16 yards x 10 yards with a depth of one and a half feet to three and a half feet.

**Q. When is lap swim?**

A. There are designated lap swim times throughout the week but we strive to keep at least two lap lanes open at all times. Of course this may change due to swim lesson volume and swim meets.

**Q. What is the temperature of the pool?**

A. The pool temperature may vary based on the outside air temperature, rainfall and backwashing the pool, but we try to keep the temperature of the water to between 78-83 degrees.

**Q. What is the ratio for swim lessons?**

A. The ratio for pre-school lessons is 6:1 while the youth lessons is 10:1.

**Q. Are toys allowed in the pool?**

A. Toys cannot be brought in from outside the YMCA.

**Q. How do you reserve a pool party?**

A. Contact the YMCA at 590-9622. All pool parties must be reserved at least two weeks prior to the party date.

**Q. Can we bring food into the pool area?**

A. Glass containers are not allowed anywhere on the pool deck at any time. Food and beverages are allowed only in the covered area of the pool deck.

**Q. Can non-members swim in the YMCA pool?**

A. Non-members can swim at the YMCA pool by paying the YMCA day fee.

**Q. Can my child wear floaties in the pool?**

A. All floatation devices must be Coast Guard approved (it will state this on the floatation device). Inflatable arm bands (or any other inflatable floatation device) are not allowed. The YMCA has a limited amount of lifejackets available for use.

**Q. Does my child have to be potty trained in order to swim in the pool?**

A. Children that are not potty trained must wear swim diapers. Regular diapers are not strong enough to hold up in the pool.



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
